To apply for C4 2017's Student Delegate Program you must:

- Be enrolled in or have recently graduated from a Canadian University or College
- Be involved in or have conducted research relating to the following topics: Climate Change, Adaptation, Resiliency, Economics, Actuarial Sciences, Emergency Management, Engineering, Meteorology, Hydrology, Earth Science, Seismology, Risk Management, Geography, Socio-economics or other fields related to Catastrophes

Your submission should include (in word or pdf format):

- 1. A cover letter describing why you believe you should be selected as a Student Delegate (Max 1 page)
- 2. An abstract of the research you wish to present and discuss (Max 1 page)
- 3. A resume or CV with your contact information and relevant education (Max 1 page)
