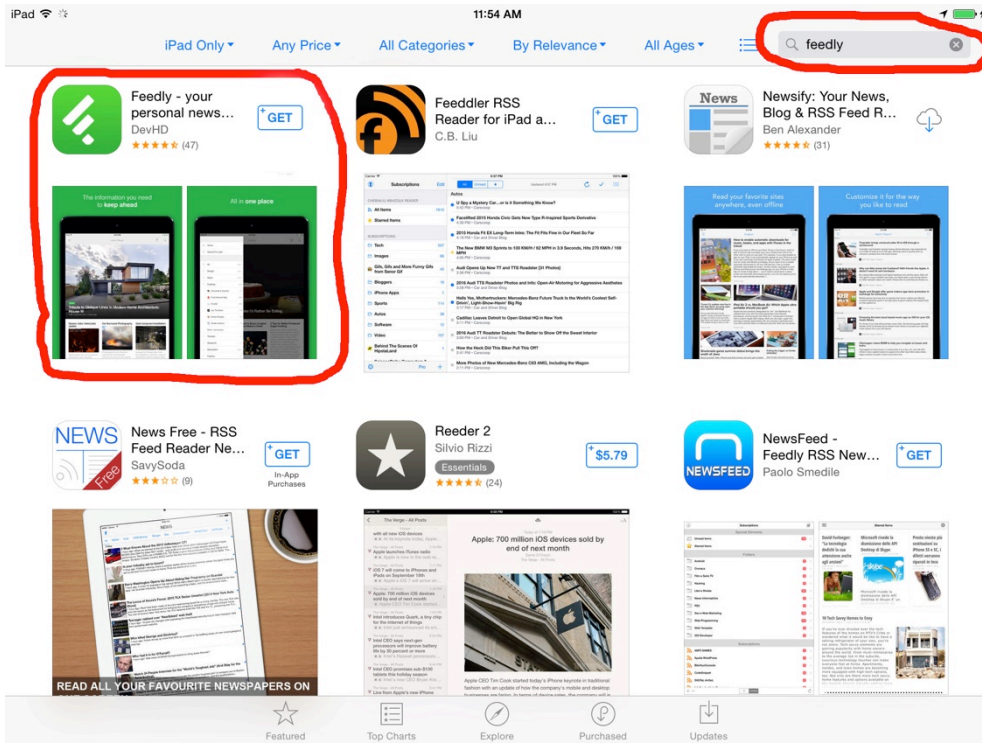
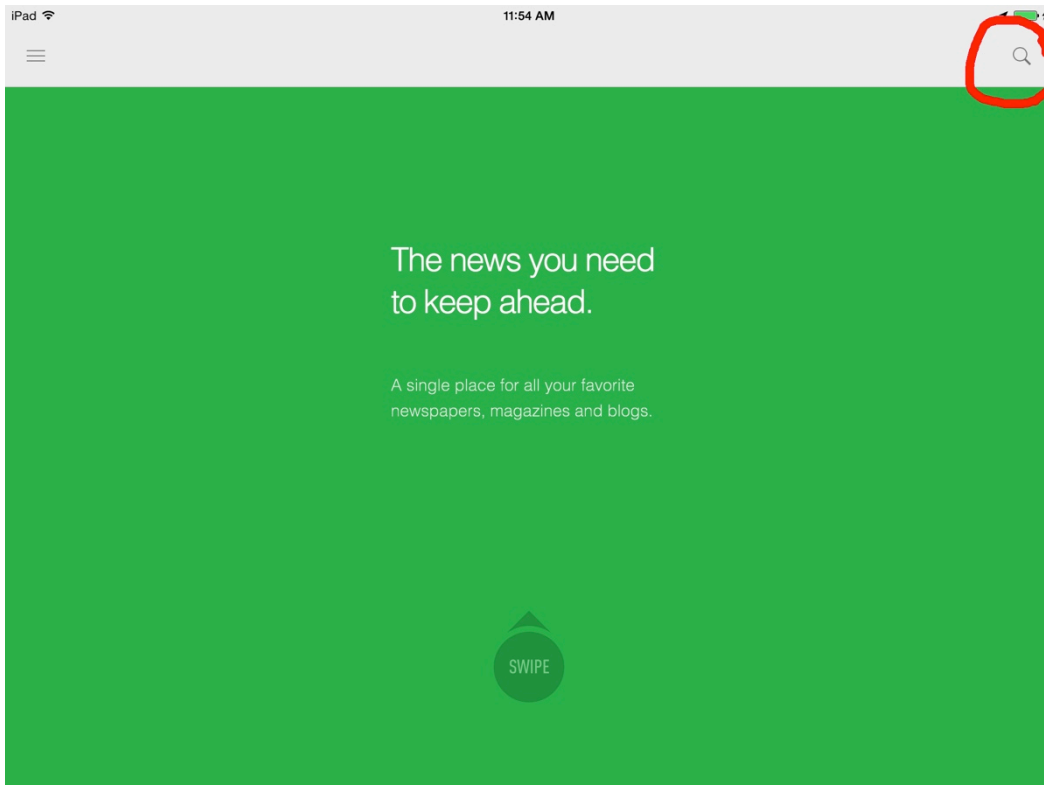


How to Install The WIRE on Your Smart Phone or Tablet

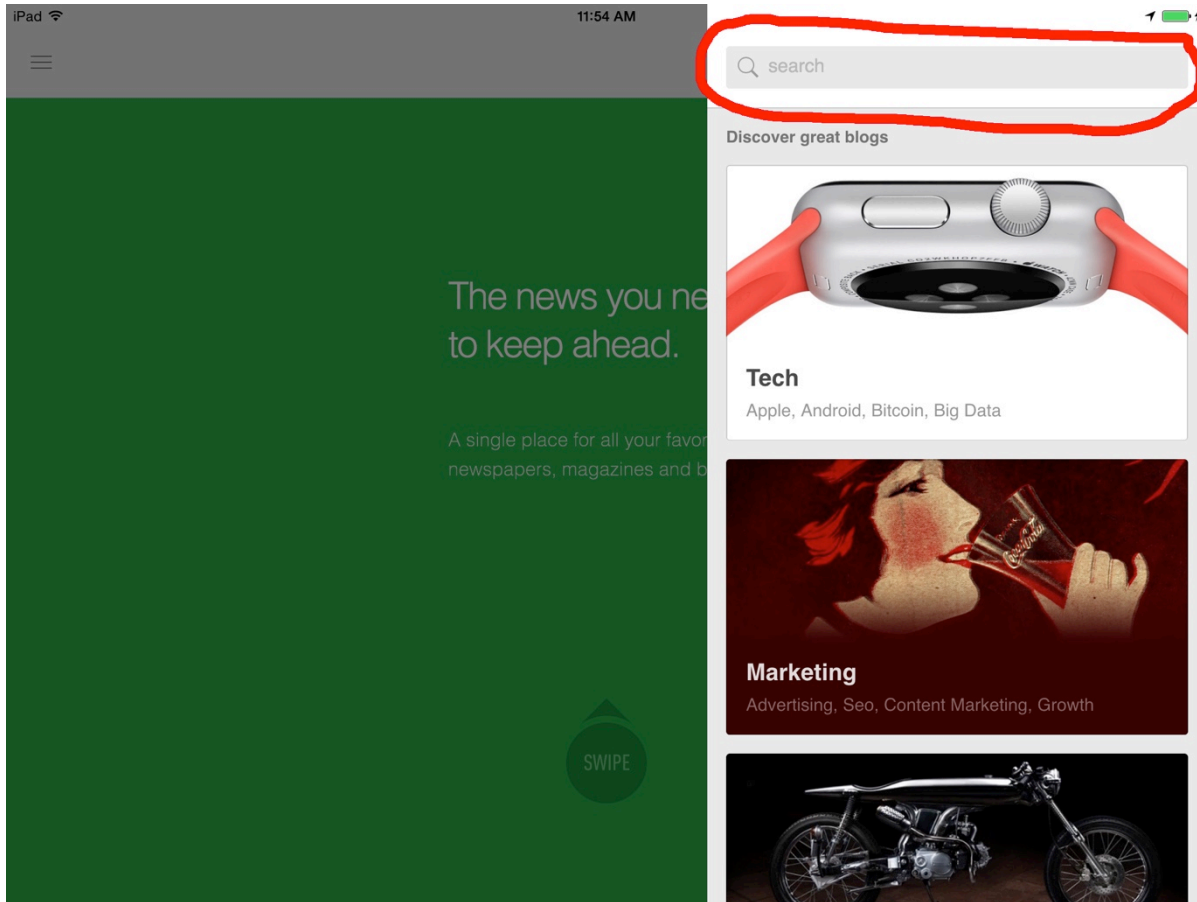
1. On your hand-held device, go to the online store where you purchase apps. (I'm using an iPad as an example in the photos). Search "Feedly" and download it to your device.



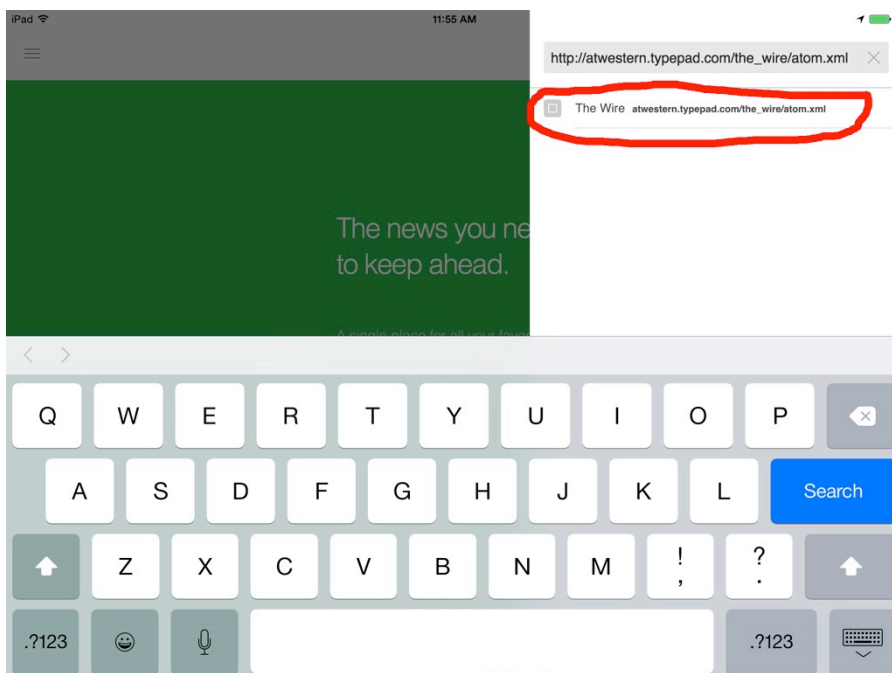
2. Click the magnifying glass in the top right corner to open the search box.



3. In the “search” box, type: http://atwestern.typepad.com/the_wire/atom.xml

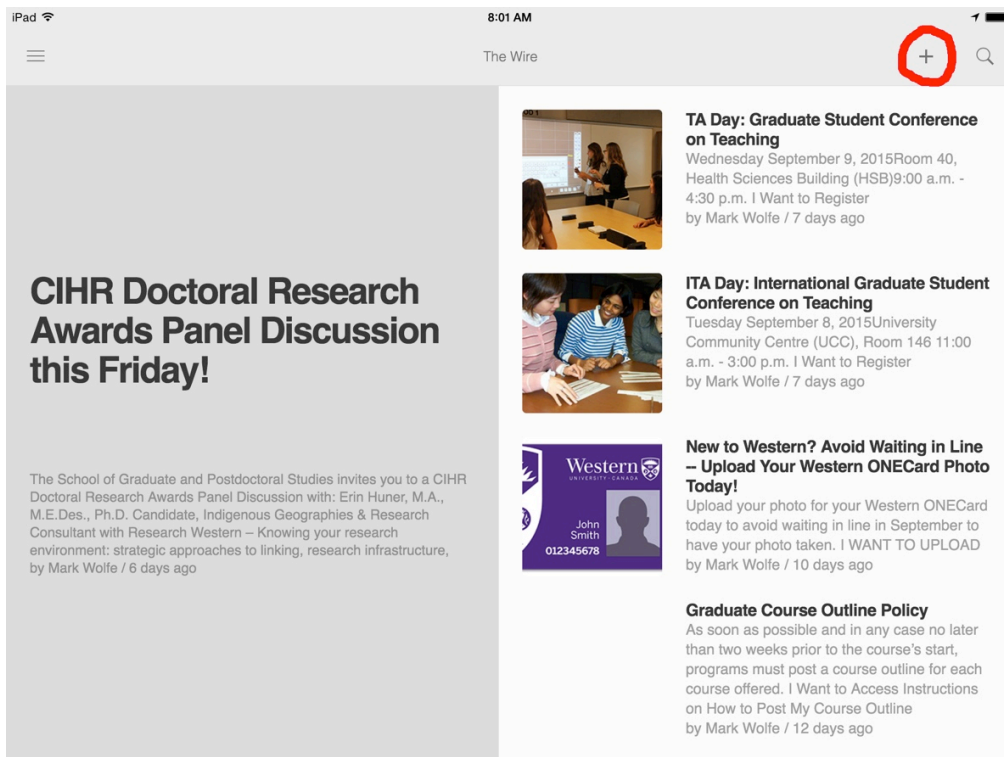


4. Below the “search” box, tap the new entry **The Wire** atwestern.typepad.com ...

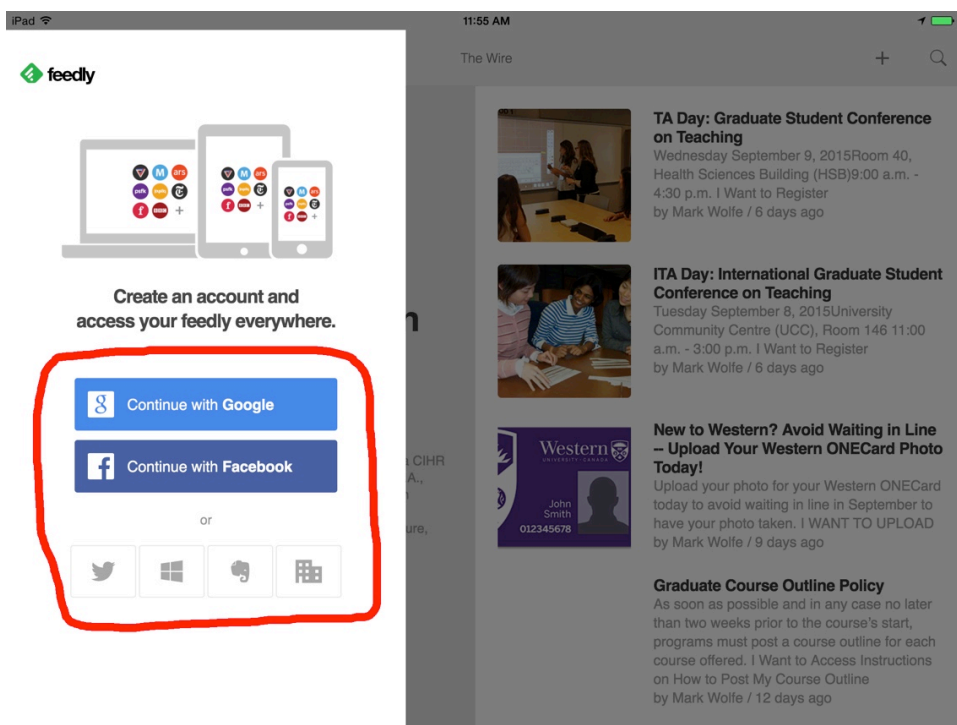


IF YOU HAVEN'T SIGNED IN YET ...

5. Tap the “+” sign in the top right corner.

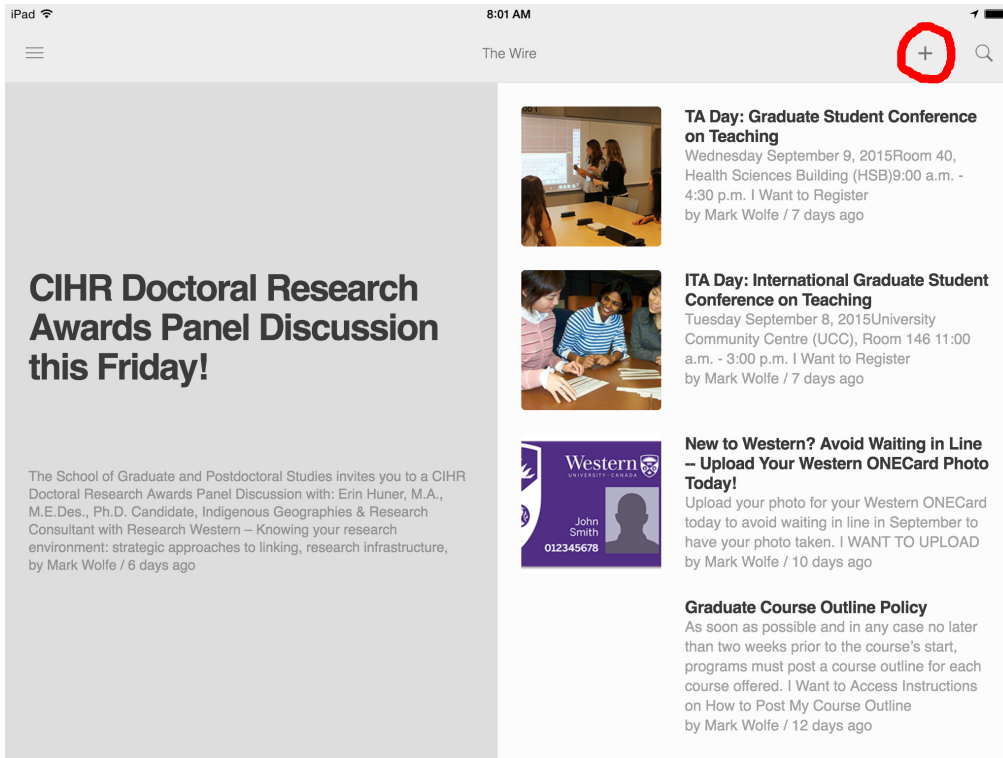


6. Sign in with your Google, Facebook, etc. account, and follow the prompts to save The WIRE feed to your Feedly app. (Note: if you don't do this, you'll have to input the URL above every time you sign in to Feedly.) **PROCEED TO STEP #10.**

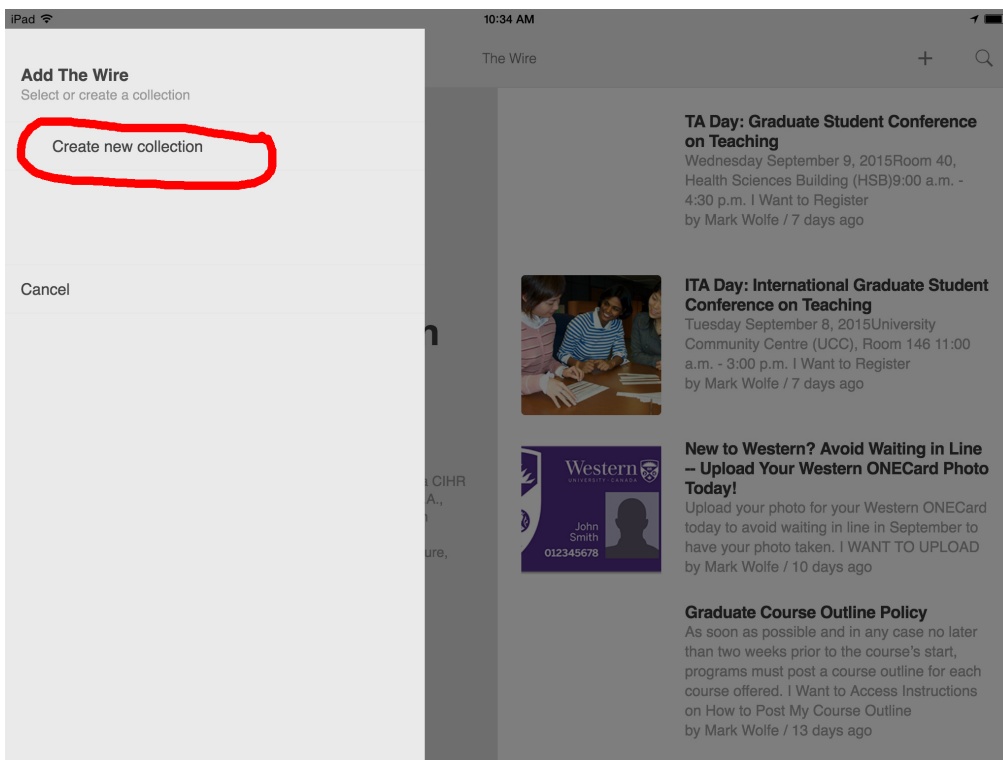

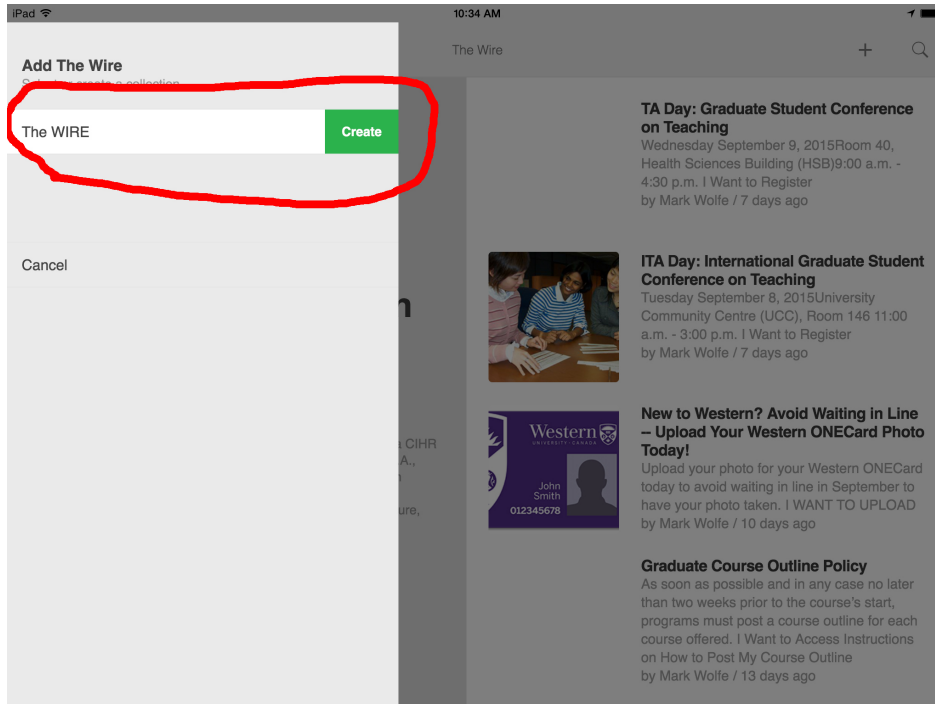
7. Tap the “+” sign in the top right corner.



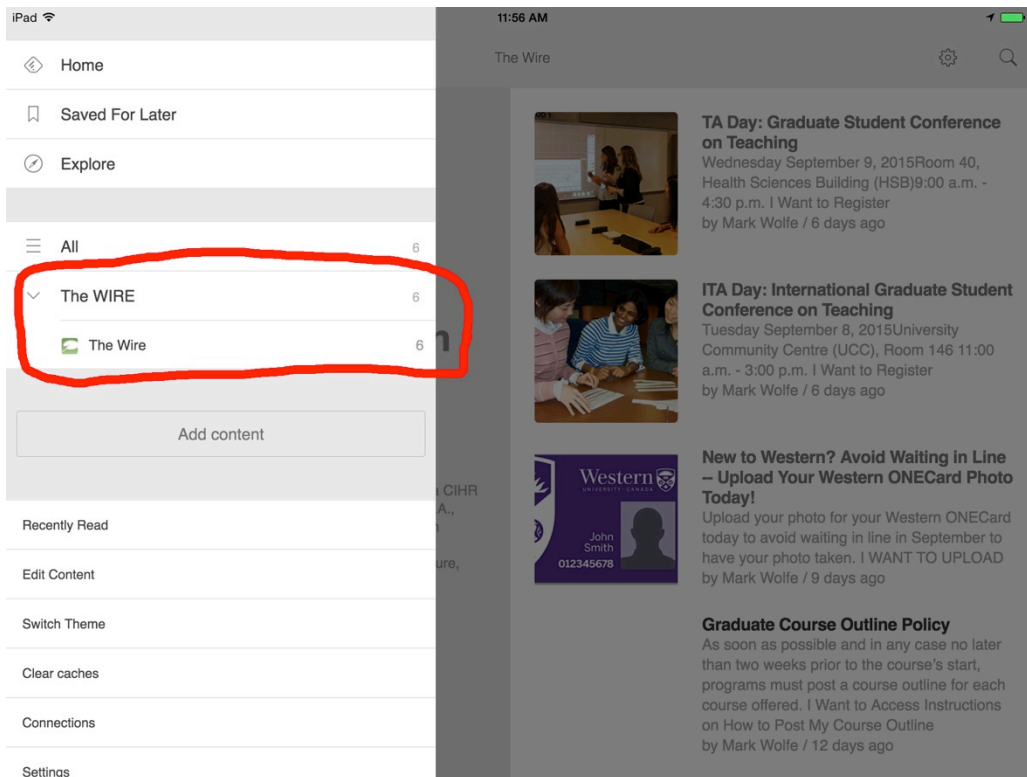
8. Tap “Create new collection”.
