
## Help with this Page

Applicants whose first language is not English must furnish evidence of their proficiency in the use of the English language by a satisfactory achievement within the last two years.

The only exemption from this rule, is applicants who have studied 2 or more years in an English speaking university in a country with English as the official language.

The application invites you to self-report a test and score you have already completed.

Please enter the test which you wrote the test and the type of test you completed. The acceptable ELP tests are provided in a drop-down selection under Test ID.
