



How to Add The WIRE RSS Feed to Google Chrome (In 10 easy steps!)


1. Open Google Chrome.
2. Click this link (or copy and paste it) into Chrome:

3. Click "+Add to Chrome" in the blue box.



4. Click "Add"



5. You'll see the RSS symbol in the top right-hand corner of your browser.






8. Click the RSS symbol. You'll see a box open up with "Click here to add feeds". Click the "+" symbol with the superscript "1".




9. Click the green “Follow” button. It will change to “Following”. Then click the “x” to the left of “Add new feed or folder”.



Your RSS feed will now show The WIRE.



10. Click on “The WIRE” and it will expand the box to show the latest posts. You can toggle your feed view on and off by simply clicking the RSS feed icon.



You can also follow this process to add any RSS feed to your Chrome browser!
