Qualified applicants for this position should have a PhD degree in Pharmacology or a related discipline, significant experience in techniques including mass spectrometry, molecular biology, gene cloning and expression, genetic analysis, biochemical and functional assays, cell culture, viral transduction, quantitative PCR analysis and mouse care. Expertise in pharmacokinetic/pharmacodynamic modeling and statistical analysis of genetic information would be an asset. A competitive stipend will be paid commensurate with experience.
