About the Role:

Specifically, the PDA will support research projects related to trauma-and violence-informed health promotion, program evaluation, and sustainability. The PDA will be responsible for various research activities including conducting literature reviews, preparing ethics application submissions, collecting and analyzing data and writing articles for publication. Additionally, the PDA will support knowledge mobilization through various activities as identified with project leads.

Key Responsibilities:

Develops systems, processes and procedures for timely data collection, prepares and submits ethics protocols, collects and analyzes data, completes statistical and qualitative analysis on new and available data sets, conducts literature reviews and prepares manuscripts and technical documents for publication; present findings of research to professional groups, other researchers and community partners.
